

Weathering the weather is a website that makes light of the physical and mental sensations through an alligator named Clyde.


INSPIRATION


THE OBJECTIVE



Weather Feels



FUNCTIONALITY




Speaking Code

This website targets the weather information via Weather Underground through a JavaScript file. In this project we used a JavaScript built in tool called JSON to get the weather responses that we wanted to use.




Wild is the Wind

When it's windy Clyde flies through the air and bends in half, the clouds move backwards and the water ripples.




It's Raining Cats and Alligators?

It's literally raining alligators when it rains. Also, a school of fish move horizontally across the page.




Dancing in the Street

Clyde does not handle hot environments very well. When the temperature rises to 75 degrees or above, Clyde's attitude and appearance change.


