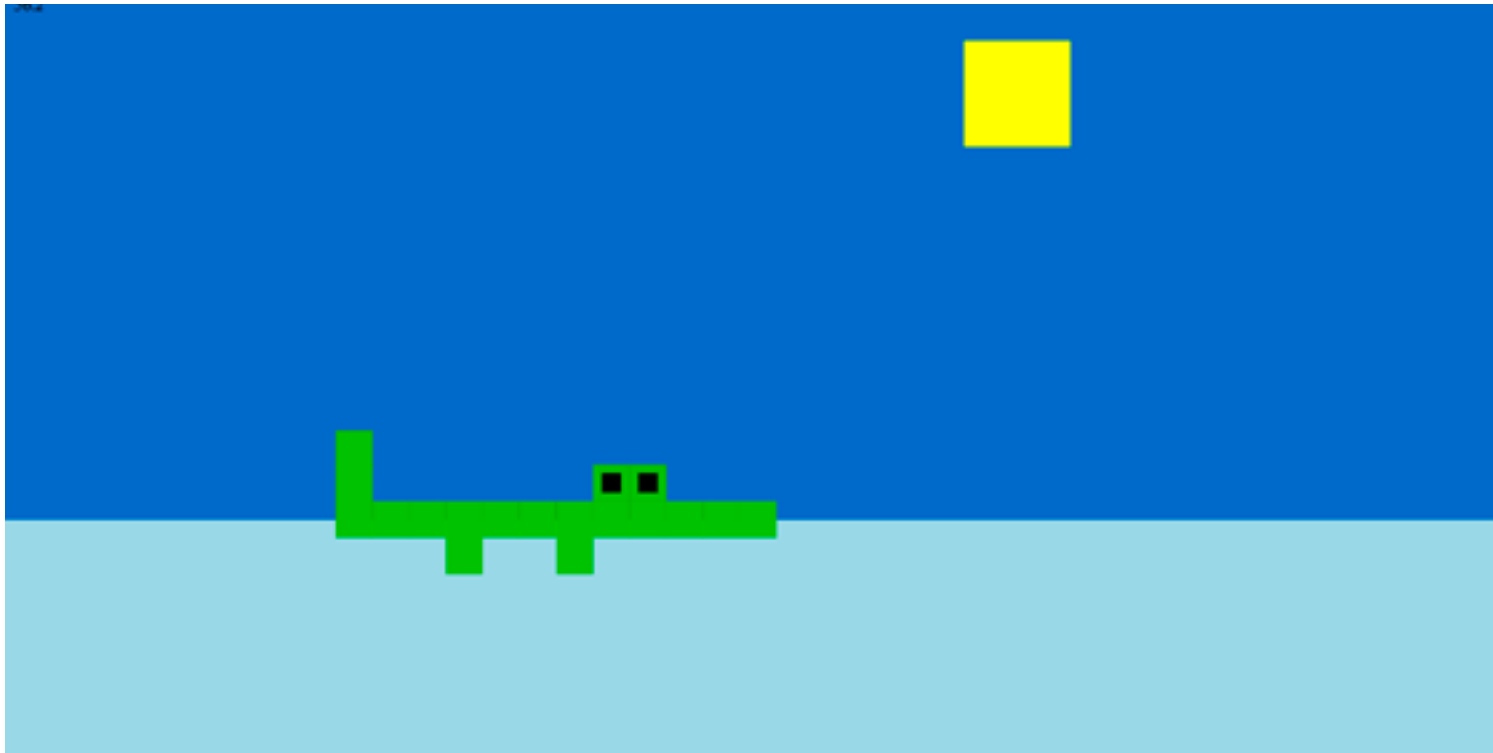


WEATHERING THE WEATHER



INTRODUCTION

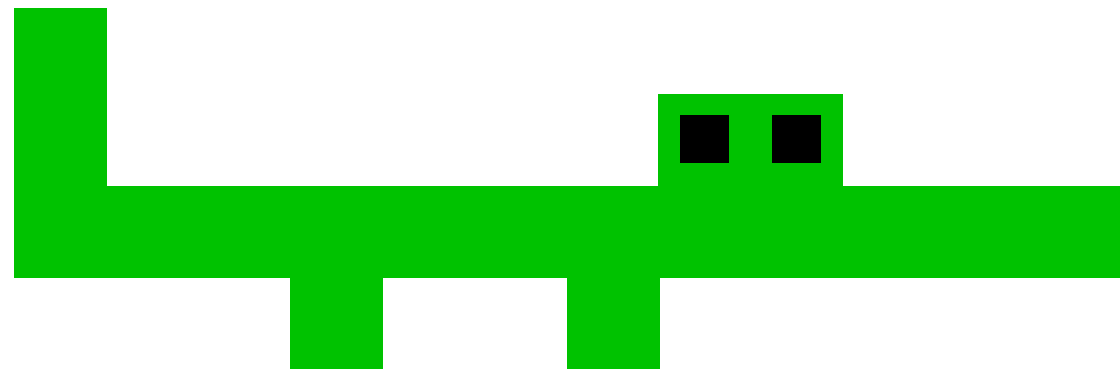

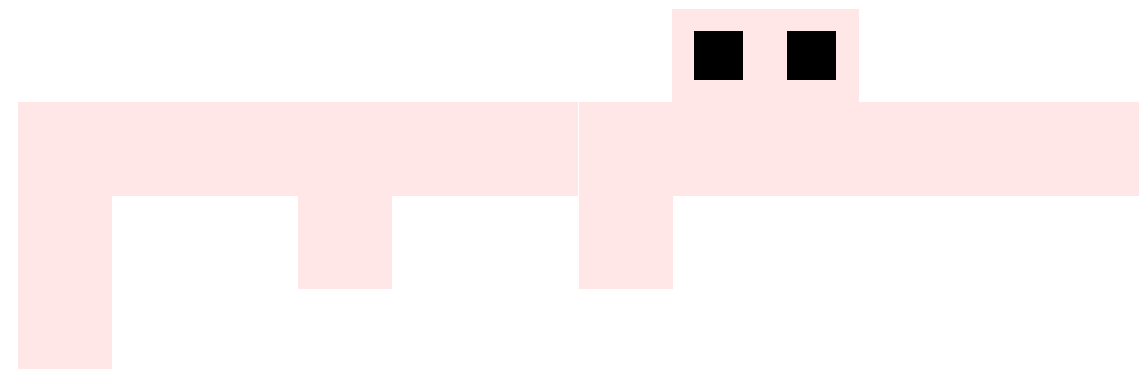

Happy Clyde

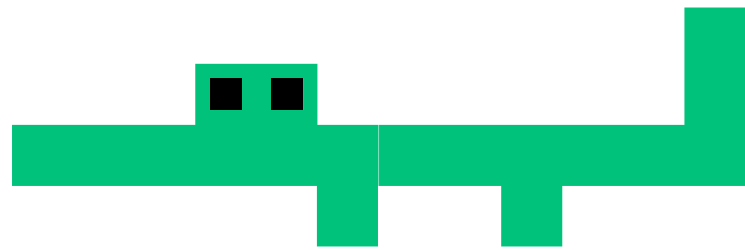


Sad or Cold Clyde

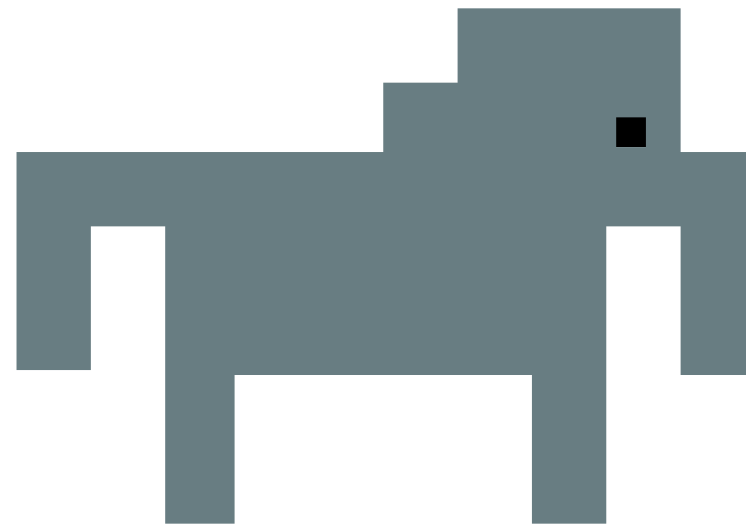
DIFFERENT STATES

Like Clyde, the other animal's behaviors and appearance change depending on certain weather conditions. Also, certain temperatures and weather states bring back memories from their natural habitats.

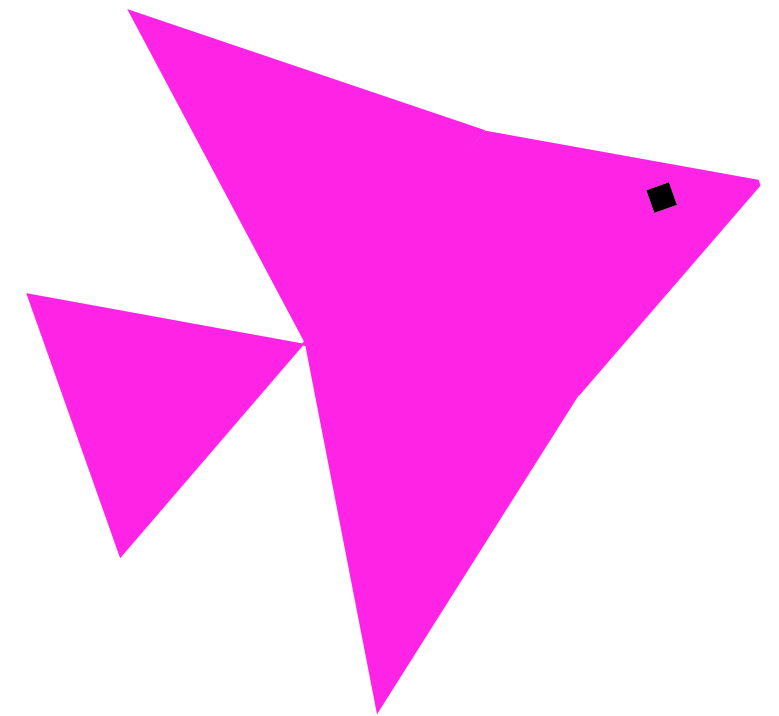

Dumbo the Elephant

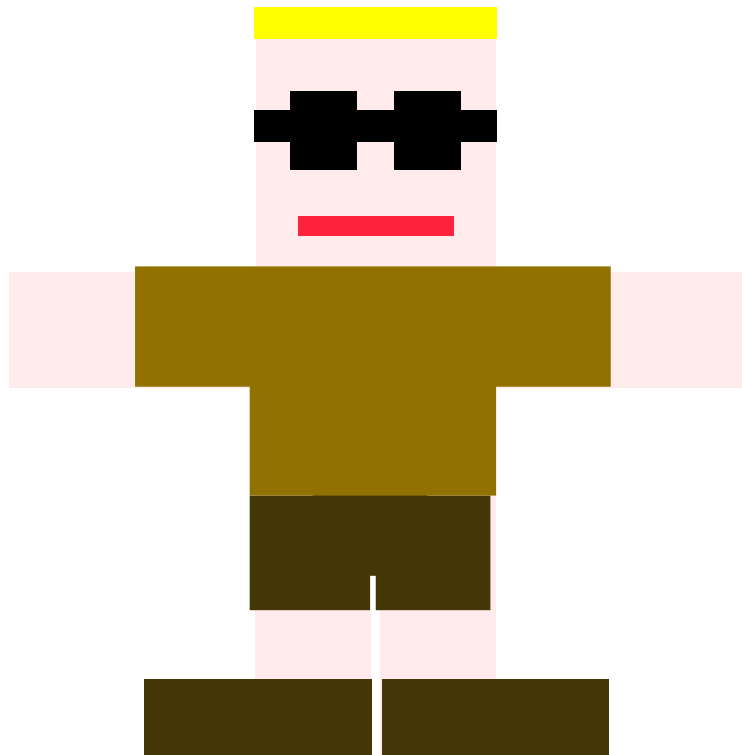


Fishy the Fish

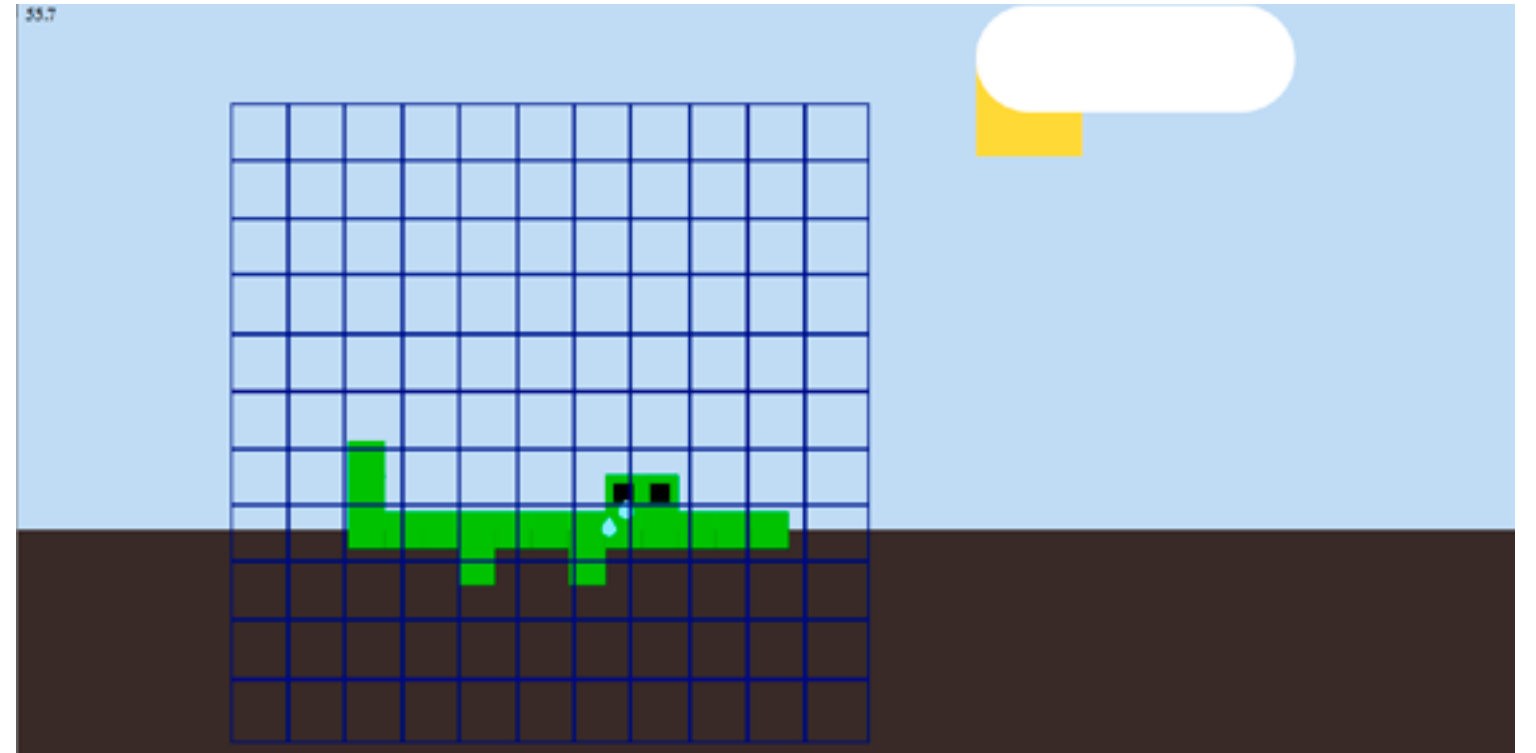
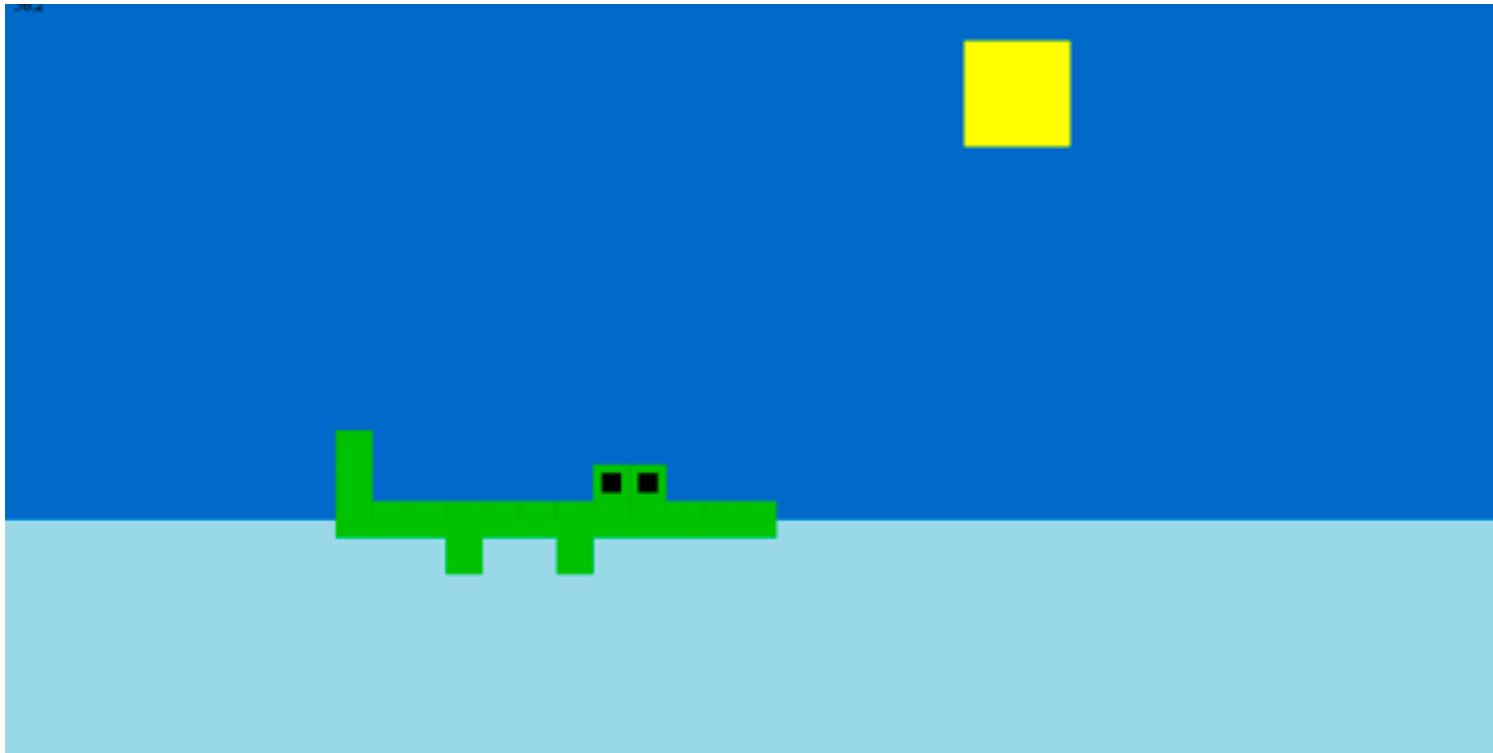
GAME CHALLENGES
